Whilst we are still awaiting our report from the Catholic School's Inspection on the 9th and 10th May, it was useful experience as our first major inspection since the Ofsted judgment in Nov 2022. The LGB role in monitoring the curriculum has improved and they will be in school twice after half term to evaluate standards for greater depth pupils and those receiving pupil premium.
